

RESOLUTION 2006-10, AUTHORIZING A MORATORIUM ON WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS OUTSIDE THE TOWN'S MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES

Councilor Clauss made a motion to adopt Resolution 2006-10, with the amendment to add the words "90-day" in the title. Councilor Nupp seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION 2006-11, SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM (MAP) FUNDING

Councilor May made a motion to adopt Resolution 2006-11, which was seconded by Councilor Ward and passed unanimously.

SWIMMING POOL ISSUES

After a discussion about the status of the old swimming pool boiler and an explanation of the cost and other things that will need to be done for a new heater, the Council agreed by consensus that a bid should go out as soon as possible. Mr. Brown said that a 10-day bid could be done to speed up the process. Councilor Nupp said he would like to see solar heating explored. In addition to purchasing a new heater, some additional plumbing will need to be done as well as a louvered door installed on the heater room so that it will have more air circulating and won't get too hot. Mr. Brown said that this item would be a budget adjustment. Councilor May said that the Town needs to do this because we owe it to the public to take care of the pool. Mr. Brown commented that fees for the pool were decreased a few years ago and in addition Saturday's have been free. He said that he would like to continue this.
