**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY
SUPPORTING THE NAMING OF THE HUDSON STREET BRIDGE LOCATED ON
HIGHWAY 90 IN SILVER CITY AS “THE VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE”**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Silver City recognizes that throughout the years of the Town’s existence, many of its men and woman have served honorably in the armed forces of this nation, and that many have made the ultimate sacrifice of their lives; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council intends to honor these men and women by giving its support to the State of New Mexico, Department of Transportation in its efforts to name the newly reconstructed Hudson Street Bridge located on Highway 90 in Silver City as “The Veterans Memorial Bridge”, and to place a plaque upon said bridge in an honored and prominent location, proclaiming its name to all who pass;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Silver City hereby petitions and requests the State of New Mexico, Department of Transportation, to officially name the newly reconstructed Hudson Street Bridge located on Highway 90 in Silver City as “The Veterans Memorial Bridge”; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Silver City shall install, within one year of the naming by the State Transportation Commission, the appropriate signs or plaques in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and inspect annually and perform all maintenance, repairs and replacement of the signs or plaques at no cost to the New Mexico Department of Transportation.
