

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-35

**SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO
FINANCE AUTHORITY UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

WHEREAS, Town of Silver City was designated a Colonia on August 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Town of Silver City is in need of Water System Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will be constructed along New Mexico Highway 15, also known as Pinos Altos Road, from Newsham Street to Pine Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will benefit low income individuals and families, local residents, public services, and two water associations connected to the Town's water system; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, loan and match requirements, and any requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the governing body in and for the Town of Silver City that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Silver City that it endorses and supports an application for FY 2017/2018 Colonias Infrastructure Funding; and that

1. The Mayor of the Town of Silver City, or his designee, is hereby directed to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City for funding assistance from the New Mexico Finance Authority Colonias Infrastructure Fund for Water System Improvements along New Mexico Highway 15, also known as Pinos Altos Road, from Newsham Street to Pine Street.
2. The Town Council directs and designates Alex C. Brown, Town Manager, as the authorized representative to act in all matters in connection with this application, and to do all acts necessary to carry out the intent of the Resolution.
