

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-36**

**SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY  
UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

**WHEREAS**, Town of Silver City was designated a Colonia on August 1, 1991; and

**WHEREAS**, Town of Silver City is in need of a **Survey & Design Project for Street Improvements**; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed project will be constructed on **Ridge Road** from New Mexico Highway 90 to the City Limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed project will benefit low income individuals/families, local residents, and public services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Silver City assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, loan and match requirements, and any requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of the Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the majority opinion of the governing body in and for the Town of Silver City that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Silver City that it endorses and supports an application for FY 2017/2018 Colonias Infrastructure Funding; and

The Town Council directs the Town Manager to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City for funding assistance from the New Mexico Finance Authority Colonias Infrastructure Fund for a Survey and Design Project for Street Improvements on Ridge Road from New Mexico Highway 90 to the City Limits. The Town Manager is designated to act in all matters in connection with this application, and to do all acts necessary to carry out the intent of the Resolution.
