

P R O C L A M A T I O N

A DAY TO HONOR THE TERRITORIAL CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY, GRANT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1878, the Speaker of the Territorial House of Representatives of the State of New Mexico, Juan B. Patron, presided over passage of “An Act to incorporate the Town of Silver City in the County of Grant” which was signed that day by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, this act of incorporation constitutes the official recognition by the Territory of New Mexico that certain rights and powers of self-government shall be granted in perpetuity to the citizens of the Town of Silver City; and

WHEREAS, for one hundred and forty-one years, this Territorial Charter has provided a model of local self-government in the State of New Mexico to provide for the health, safety and welfare of its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2016-02, the Town Council of the Town of Silver City deemed it appropriate that the Town and its inhabitants shall annually honor the passage of its Territorial Charter, and remember those persons responsible therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ken Ladner, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Silver City, Grant County, New Mexico do hereby proclaim February 16, 2019 as

"TERRITORIAL CHARTER DAY"

and that the inhabitants of the Town are encouraged to honor said day with a recollection of the Town’s history and such celebrations as might be deemed appropriate.
