## Informational Report

### 2009 Citations Summary:

The total number of citations issued for 2009 was 10,356; which was an increase of 22% over 2008. The total citations issued for 2008 was 8061. As additional information; the total citations issued for 2007 was 7764. The following is a comparison of citations issued for the reporting years.

### Citation Day & Time Report:

The following information is being provided as an insight to citations issued from Sunday through Saturday, midnight to midnight, for the 24 hour period.

The most citations (766) issued in a one hour period was between 11 pm and 12 am. This one hour period accounted for 7.4% of the citations issued. The second most citations (762) were issued between 12 and 1 pm. This hour accounted for 7.4% as well. The hour showing the least number of citations (46) issued is between 3 and 4 am.

The most productive day of the week for the issuance of citations (1,675) was Friday, which accounted for 16.2% of the citations issued during 2009. The second most productive day was Thursday, which accounted for 16.2% of the citations (1,628). Sunday showed the least number of citations (949) issued, and accounted for 9.2% of overall citations issued.

Note: <sup>A</sup> : The registration and license plate violation encompasses all violations under these sections. These range from an expired vehicle registration to an expired license plate tag.

<sup>B</sup> : The drivers license violations encompasses all violations under these sections. The violations range from no drivers license in possession to driving under suspension or revocation.

<sup>C</sup> - The Driving under Revocation is also included in #4.

All percentages were rounded to the nearest whole number.
