

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-18

**PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM
ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Silver City and the New Mexico Department of Transportation have determined that it is in the public interest to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with regard to a certain road project within the Town of Silver City; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$63,937.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$47,953.00; and
- b. The Town of Silver City's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$15,984.00;
and
- c. The Town of Silver City shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$63,937.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Silver City that:

- 1. The Town of Silver City shall, and does hereby enter into a Cooperative Agreement, Control Number **HW2 L100417** with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for a LGRF Project for year 2019/2020 with a project scope: **“Project development, Construction and materials (purchasing through state pricing agreement) for a Chip Seal and Fog Seal – Bennett Street – Silver Heights Blvd. to Dead End; Cecelia Street – Pine Street to Dead End; Cherry Hills Place – Pine Street to end of Cul de Sac; Corbin Street – Silver Heights Blvd. to 12th Street; Gold Street – Silver Heights Blvd. to Swan Street; Katheryne Circle – Pine Street to Pine Street; Kimberly Street – Pine Street to Pinos Altos Road; Kris Circle – Swarthmore Drive to end of Cul de Sac; Memory Lane – US Highway 180 to Dead End; Paul Place – Kimberly Street to end of Cul de Sac; Pine Street – Silver Street to Pinos Altos Road; Ranch Club Road – US Highway 180 to Pinos Altos Road; Swarthmore Drive – Pine Street to Valle Drive; Todd Circle – Swarthmore Drive to end of Cul de Sac; Valle Drive – Kimberly Street to Dead End; Village Drive – Pine Street to end of Cul de Sac; 13th Street – Hudson Street to Swan Street; 14th Street – Hudson Street to Corbin Street; 16th Street – Silver Heights Blvd. to Swan Street; 17th Street – Silver Heights Blvd. to Gold Street.”**
- 2. The referenced Cooperative Agreement project is adopted and has priority standing.
- 3. The Cooperative Agreement terminates on December 31, 2020 and the Town of Silver City incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.
- 4. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents on behalf of the Town of Silver City in furtherance of the above-described project.
