

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-07

**SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY
UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City was designated a Colonia on August 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City is in need of a **Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Little Walnut Road, Phase IV Construction**; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will be constructed on **Little Walnut Road** from 1200 ft. north of Chavez Lane to 1170 ft. south of Jack Frost Drive; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will benefit low-income individuals, families, local residents and public services; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, loan and match requirements and any requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of Colonias Infrastructure funding; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the governing body in and for the Town of Silver City that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Silver City that it endorses and supports an application for Fiscal Year 2023 Colonias Infrastructure Funding; and

The Town Council directs the Town Manager, Alex C. Brown to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City for funding assistance from the New Mexico Finance Authority Colonias Infrastructure Fund for a Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Little Walnut Road, Phase IV Construction from 1200 ft. north of Chavez Lane to 1170 ft. south of Jack Frost Drive. The Town Manager is designated to act in all matters in connection with this application, and to do all acts necessary to carry out the intent of the Resolution.
