

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-10

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING WATER RATES

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City maintains a “Water Fund” to cover the costs of constructing, maintaining, expanding and repairing its water distribution and collection systems, including costs of debt associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Silver City reaffirms the policy of the Town that the water fund shall not be subsidized, and that said fund shall be maintained at a sufficient level for its purposes through prudent and reasonable rates imposed upon the consumers of water services; and

WHEREAS, Section 52-71 of the Town’s Municipal Code require the Town Manager to make his recommendations to the Town Council regarding water rates for the twelve months following; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager of the Town has analyzed the current rates and the necessary expenditures of the Town for the aforementioned water service and has determined that certain modest rate increases are prudent for the maintenance of the fund and the economic well-being of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is satisfied that the recommendations of the Town Manager are necessary for the health, safety and well-being of the Town;

WHEREAS, sewer rates will remain unchanged at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Silver City, Grant County, New Mexico has adopted the Town Manager’s recommended changes to the water rates, which are described in Appendix “A”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by

this reference, with said rates to become effective on July 1, 2023.
